An Interview with Benson Silweya

When did you start running?

I started running short distances, 4 –5km, in 2020. By 2023 I was collecting medals – my first for a 7.5km.

What's the motivation behind running?

Improving my physical wellbeing was my primary objective, but along the way I realised that during and after a race my mind is opened. A lot happens during a race: negative energy is suppressed, you feel how much more your body can push. Additionally, running lets me to explore new places, especially longer routes or trail runs. I also enjoy group running for the positive morale and motivation to reach the finish line.

What role does UltraLime play in your running?

It helps me with my weekly training routine and accumulating more kilometres.

How has your running journey inspired other CMO employees?

I have noticed more employees coming on board; especially for local events. But it's really them inspiring me when they ask about the next marathon.

What's next - do you have an upcoming race that you're training for?

I'm doing the Kitwe marathon in June. And, if I train well, I plan to hit the next barrier by running the Comrades Marathon in 2026.
