### Carmeuse Overseas hosts first Sustainability Workshop



Last month, we hosted our first CMO-wide sustainability workshop, bringing together representatives from Senegal, Mauritania, Ivory Coast, Ghana, Tunisia, and Zambia.

The week was filled with collaborative sessions focused on strengthening teamwork, improving how we report on our sustainability actions, and identifying opportunities for long-term impact.

The team is also working on two big projects (one for Pink October and one for teaching school children about protecting our water sources and practicing good water hygiene and sanitation) that we'll roll out later this year.
